After Close of Public Hearing

Mr. Gurski: I'm going to close the public part of this case and recognize Mr. Lockwood.

Mr. Lockwood: ON SPECIAL EXCEPTION 80-P-078, I MOVE THAT THE PLANNING COMMISSION RECOMMEND FAVORABLE APPROVAL BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS ON THIS APPLICATION SUBJECT TO THE CONDITIONS LISTED IN APPENDIX 1 OF THE STAFF REPORT.

Mr. Lovelace: Second.

Mr. Gurski: Seconded by Mr. Lovelace. Any discussion?
Mr. Lockwood, a comment. I'm glad that you moved this hearing along and I won't delay it except for a brief comment.
