After the close of the Public Hearing

Chairman Brinitzer: And by virtue of the fact that this is a Providence Case, we'll turn to the Commissioner of that District, Mrs. Annunziata for action on the case.

Commissioner Annunziata: Mr. Chairman I think my "mike" is still off. Can I just proceed --

Chairman Brinitzer: Oh, I think Mr. Murphy will be gallant.

Commissioner Annunziata: Mr. Chairman I'll be brief. For the reasons stated in the staff report and presented here orally this evening, I would MOVE THAT, I am planning to move that this application SEA-80-P-078-1 be approved. I'm going to make an amendment to the proposed development conditions, and I would like to address the motion, just briefly after it's seconded, if it is seconded. The motion is as follows: I would MOVE THAT WE RECOMMEND TO THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS APPROVAL OF SEA-80-P-078-1, SUBJECT TO THE CONDITIONS LISTED, IN THE REVISED APPENDIX DATED 7/20/83 WITH THE EXCEPTION OF CONDITION NUMBER 5, WHICH WILL BE DELETED.

Chairman Brinitzer: Okay, this is a recommendation for approval?

Commissioner Annunziata: Yes sir.

Chairman Brinitzer: Okay, it's seconded by Mrs. Fasteau. Is there any discussion on the motion? If not all those in favor of Mrs. Annunziata's motion, please specify by saying aye.

Commissioner Annunziata: Mr. Chairman, excuse me, before the vote I did say I wanted to make one comment about the exclusion of condition number 5. If I may.

Chairman Brinitzer: All right. Why don't we have a discussion first before we go into a motion.

Commissioner Annunziata: Just, very briefly, that's the condition that speaks to the acoustical treatment of the trailers. I'm excluding that from the conditions, on the basis of two factors that were drawn to our attention by the applicant. One, these are temporary structures which should be removed probably, within 12 months, my understanding. And second, it leaves the sleeping

to back positioning of the other two, at least, there should be an attenuation just by virtue of the location of the, trailers, an attenuation of the noise on the conference trailer.

Chairman Brinitzer: Okay. Any other comments? All those in favor of Mrs. Annunziata's motion, please specify by saying aye.

Commissioners: Aye.

Chairman Brinitzer: Those opposed? The motion carries unanimously.
