S.E.#116-A-79 - RAVENSWORTH TRUST PARTNERSHIP

After close of public hearing.

Mr. Gurski: I'm going to close the public hearing and recognize Commissioner Paul Keast, Commissioner of the Annandale District for any action he may propose.

Mr. Keast: In conclusion... Mr. Chairman, I need to make a statement. I have an existing bank account with the Northern Virginia Bank, however, I don't think they're large enough to ask me to disqualify myself from addressing this particular case. Unfortunately. As you Mr. Chairman have said, the area in question is a heavily impacted area especially on Saturday mornings in summer. The drivers not only enter from Braddock Road but turn through the shopping center itself. And since I have your undivided attention at this point, I would like to RECOMMEND THAT WE APPROVE SPECIAL EXCEPTION 116-A-79 AND RECOMMEND THAT THE BOARD ACCEPT THAT TOGETHER WITH THE PARKING STUDY AS NOTED IN THE STAFF REPORT.

Mr. Gurski: Is there a second to that motion? Seconded by Mr. Lockwood. For the record, I too, like Mr. Keast, have a customer relationship with the Northern Virginia Bank, I believe. But I still have a small savings account and a safety deposit box at that bank. And I intend to vote. I see no conflict at all. These are declared in my financial statement. If you're ready for the question, Mr. Keast has moved that we approve special exception 116-A-79. All those in favor of the motion please respond by saying aye. Opposed? The motion passes unanimously.
